



### Alumni Profile: Cleveland-Marshall Roots Go Deeper than Imagined for Kevin Butler '01

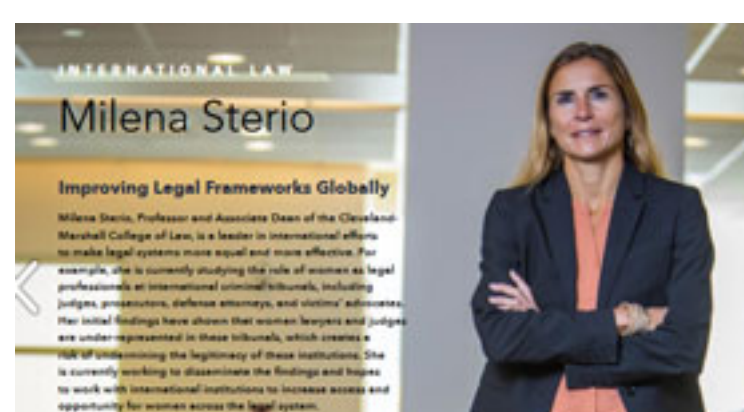

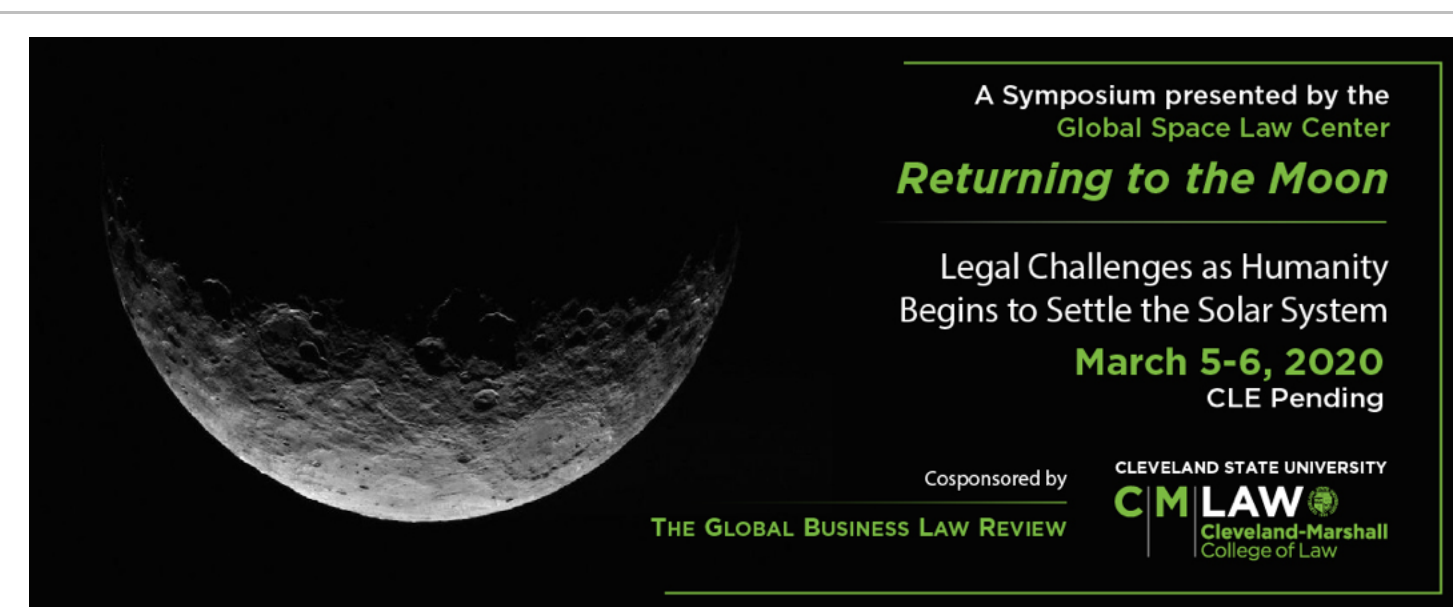

### Prof. Sagers Quoted on Warren Antitrust Bill

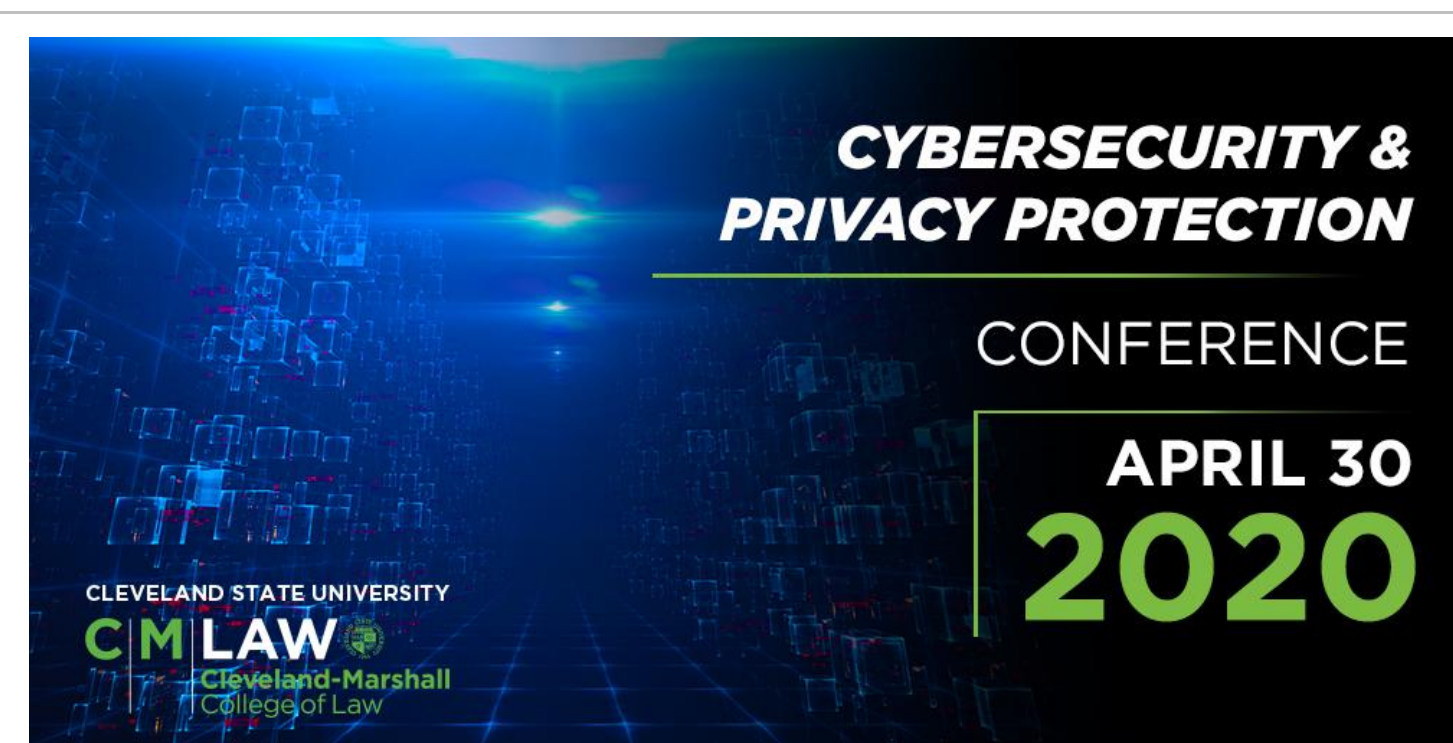
