"At the public defender's offices, I learned firsthand how to work with people of various backgrounds, which is very similar to academia," explained Jackson. "The law is meant to serve and protect people, so I interpret my role as a lawyer

and now educator, is to serve people and best prepare future lawyers." The Pardon, Clemency & Reentry Clinic was established in early 2022 to represent clients seeking pardon or clemency from the Ohio Governor, as well as reentry after a prior conviction from a court. The Clinic was developed through a partnership with the Ohio Governor's Expedited Pardon Project (OGEPP). Governor Mike DeWine launched the OGEPP in 2019 to fast-track

the pardon applications of specific candidates who have become law-abiding




